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INTRODUCTION

The entrance exam in English for foreign citizens allows for the assessment of their knowledge of English grammar and lexical rules. The purpose of the exam is to select the most prepared applicants. The entrance examination in English for foreign citizens is conducted in the form of a test. The program is based on the English language program of the External Independent Testing (EIT), approved by the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 696 dated June 26, 2018. The program will help foreign applicants identify the main sections and topics of English language theory, systematize their knowledge, and successfully prepare for and pass the entrance exam.

PROGRAM CONTENT

The program was developed in accordance with the goals and objectives that define the competencies of foreign applicants at various levels of proficiency in English as a non-native language for further study. It assesses the level of knowledge, practical skills, and abilities sufficient for effective learning in the first year of study, and most importantly, the level of foreign language communicative competence.

The materials of the program in the discipline "English Language" cover the following areas of modern linguistics:

- Phonetics. Graphics. Orthography
- Lexicology. Phraseology
- Word Structure. Word Formation
- Morphology: Noun. Adjective. Numeral. Pronoun. Verb
- Syntax: Phrase. Sentence
- Stylistics
- Literacy

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TESTING

The main purpose of the testing is to obtain comprehensive and objective information about the language proficiency of potential students of the Private Institution of Higher Education "Dnipro Institute of Medicine and Public Health," which should be reflected in their respective abilities. The tests assess the level of text comprehension, the applicant's ability to summarize the content

of the text, identify key words, and determine the meaning of unfamiliar words based on context or word-formation elements.

The applicant is expected to understand authentic texts of various genres and styles that reflect real-life situations and correspond to the age characteristics of school graduates. They should be able to find and analyze necessary information, draw conclusions from the text, identify the main idea, differentiate between key facts and secondary information, analyze and compare information, and understand logical connections between parts of the text.

The applicant reads and understands authentic texts of various genres and types, viewing them as a source of diverse information and a means of mastering it.

The selection of reading texts and writing situations should correspond to the topics of communication outlined in the Foreign Language Program.

The main criteria for selecting texts are their authenticity, clarity, length, and relevance to the interests of modern youth. The entrance exam in English for foreign citizens is conducted in the form of a written test.

Task Formats:

- *Multiple-choice questions;*

The task requires the applicant to select one correct answer from four proposed options.

The task requires the applicant to fill in the blanks in a text using the provided words or phrases.

The selection is made based on the purpose, knowledge, skills, and abilities being tested in vocabulary or grammar.

STRUCTURE AND CONTENT OF THE ENTRANCE EXAM

The entrance examination in English is conducted in the form of a written test.

The total number of tasks is 40.

The test duration is 60 minutes.

- The tasks cover all sections of the current year's Ukrainian Language Entrance Examination Program for Foreign Citizens.
- Each task consists of a question and four answer options, only one of which is correct.
- A task is considered completed if the exam participant selects and marks the answer on the answer sheet.
- The maximum score is 200 points.
- The minimum passing score ("pass/fail") is 100 points.

Appendix 1
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Criteria for Knowledge Assessment

The maximum score a test participant can achieve by correctly completing all test tasks is 200 points.

After determining the test score, the result of each applicant who passed the test is converted into a rating score on a scale from 100 to 200 points.

The test tasks are considered successfully completed if the applicant scores 100 points or more.
